**Fun ways to practice on the back 😊

At Home Kindergarten Reading

Sound Scavenger Hunt: Pick 3 letters (different letters each day) and find an object that starts with that sound

Writing ABC's and Sight Words Examples: Write with crayons, markers, pencils, paints, sidewalk chalk. Build letters with different objects (forks, spoons, straws, etc) Write in ketchup, salt, sugar, bird seed, playdough, pudding, shaving cream.

Practice Reading Sight Words: play memory, tic tac toe, find them in books, go fish, spell each word with different actions (with each letter; hop, kick, crocodile clap, etc), come up with your own game!

Read for 20 Minutes: Read to someone in your house, pet, stuffed animal, or have someone read to you.

Draw a Picture Ideas: Easter Activities (bunny, egg coloring), Spring, Robbins, Nature Walk, Picture of a friend, family, pets.

Nursery Rhymes: Jack and Jill, Wee Willie Winkie, Twinkle Twinkle, Humpty Dumpty, Little Miss Muffett, Hey Diddle Diddle, Jack be Nimble, Hickory Dickory Dock, Once I Caught A Fish Alive, 1..2.. Buckle My Shoe, This Old Man, Mary Had a Little Lamb, etc


Practice Blending Words Examples: Blending sounds into words (p-a-n = pan) Practice blending real words (pin, nut, ham, pet, fin, den, cot, run, sit) and blending nonsense or silly words (yif, fip, dop, tet, zat, sem, geck)

**Fun ways to practice on the back 😊

At Home Kindergarten Math

Writing Numbers/Phone Number: Write with crayons, markers, pencils, paints, sidewalk chalk. Build letters with different objects (forks, spoons, straws, etc) Write in ketchup, salt, sugar, bird seed, playdough, pudding, shaving cream.

Practice Number Recognition: Find numbers around the house, in books, flash cards, memory, go fish, tic tac toe, bingo, etc.

Practice Addition/Subtraction: Use items around your house for counters to add and subtract numbers up to 12 (dice, cereal, silverware, sticks, blocks, toys, playdough,

Practice Address and Birthday: Tell your address and birthday to a family member, pet, stuffed animal, etc.

Shape Hunt: Find different shapes around your house and draw the shapes that you find.

Practice Patterns: Use household items or movements to make different patterns (ex. AB- spoon, fork, spoon, fork AABB- sock sock, shoe shoe, sock sock, shoe shoe ABB- clap, stomp stomp, clap, stomp stomp ABC- jump, knock, twirl, jump, knock, twirl)
