RE-OPENING RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on or about July 13, 2020, the New York State Department of Health issued interim guidance for in-person instruction at Pre-K to Grade 12 schools during the COVID-19 public health emergency for the 2020-2021 school year; and

WHEREAS, on or about July 16, 2020, the New York State Education Department released reopening guidance for schools for the 2020-2021 school year and requiring re-opening plans to be submitted to the New York State Education Department on or before July 31, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, on August , 2020, the New York State Governor issued an Executive Order concerning the re-opening of schools for the 2020-2021 school year; and,

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Schools, working with teachers, support staff, administrators, and community groups submitted the School District's re-opening plan on July 31, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, it is understood by all that any re-opening plan for school districts and the inherent implementation of both in-person and virtual or remote instruction will change as circumstances evolve and governmental orders and guidance continue to be issued; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Education is involved in this critical policy matter.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Education resolves as follows:

- 1. The Board of Education hereby endorses the re-opening plan and efforts of the School District as led by the Superintendent of Schools. The Board recognizes that any such plan must be flexible and adapt to the COVID-19 public health emergency as it evolves and as governmental orders and guidance are issued.
- 2. The Superintendent of Schools is authorized and expected to modify and implement any re-opening plan or procedures based on such evolving circumstances and governmental orders. The Superintendent of Schools shall report to the Board as appropriate on the status of reopening and any changes in the plan or procedures that had to be made.
